

**LOWER PAXTON TOWNSHIP  
AUTHORITY MEETING**

Minutes of Township Authority Meeting held February 16, 2010

An administrative meeting of the Lower Paxton Township Authority was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Chairman William B. Hawk on the above date in the Lower Paxton Township Municipal Center, 425 Prince Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

**New Business**

Authorization for the solicitor to appeal the Dauphin County  
Common Pleas Court's decision regarding the South  
Hanover Township Zoning Hearing Board decision

Mr. Stine explained that the Authority did win on a couple of the issues that were contained in the appeal, but the one key issue, that is the crux of the entire case, is the only issue that needs to be appealed. He noted that the decision was handed down by the Dauphin County Common Pleas Court on January 25, 2010, and the Authority has until February 24, 2010 to file an appeal. He explained that he was seeking the authorization from the Authority Board to file that appeal.

Mr. Crissman made a motion to authorize Mr. Stine to appeal the Dauphin County Common Pleas Court's decision regarding the South Hanover Township Zoning Hearing Board decision. Mr. Blain seconded the motion. Mr. Hawk called for a voice vote, and a unanimous vote followed.
