



Chris Judd was elected to the Board of Supervisors in November 2017 and serves as Assistant Treasurer and a member of the Lower Paxton Authority. His priorities are to maximize communication with citizens for greater transparency; support police, fire, and emergency services; focus on core township services to keep taxes low; and implement comprehensive planning to guide smart township development.

Chris is a former Vice Chairman of the Lower Paxton Township Public Safety Committee and former member of the Lower Paxton Township Long Range Planning Advisory Committee.

As a Public Information Officer at the Pennsylvania Senate, Chris manages web and social media content, and assists with media relations and constituent outreach. He previously worked for a decade as a newspaper and radio journalist.

In addition to serving as Treasurer for the Heatherfield Community Association, Chris has been a coach with the Capital Area Soccer Association and is a former Assistant Leader with the Boy Scouts of America, Troop 368. He was among the team of volunteers that constructed the Possibility Place playground in George Park.

Prior to his election as supervisor, Chris was elected to two terms on the Central Dauphin School Board, where he served as Chairman of the Policy Committee.

Chris is a member of Charlton United Methodist Church, where he serves as Liturgist. He graduated from Temple University with a B.A. in Journalism. He and wife Paula have two children.
