

**LOWER PAXTON TOWNSHIP  
AUTHORITY MEETING**

Minutes of Township Authority Meeting held October 20, 2015

A meeting of the Lower Paxton Township Authority (LPTA) was called to order at 7:46 p.m. by Chairman William C. Seeds, Sr., on the above date in the Lower Paxton Township Municipal Center, 425 Prince Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

Authority members present in addition to Mr. Seeds were: William B. Hawk, Gary A. Crissman, Robin Lindsey, and Justin Eby. Also in attendance were George Wolfe, Township Manager, Steve Stine, Authority Solicitor, and Watson Fisher, SWAN.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Resolution 15-12; authorizing re-imbursement to PennDOT for the  
Sanitary sewer in the North Mountain Road project

Mr. Wolfe noted that the resolution authorized the reimbursement to PennDOT for the North Mountain Road project as they will be reconstructing portions of North Mountain Road. He noted that the Authority can participate in the construction project and have sanitary sewers within the road right-of-way replaced as part of the project. He noted that the Authority will pay 100% of its share of the sanitary sewer costs which include replacing manholes, main line and sewer laterals. He noted that the Authority will not have to pay for the roadway improvements and repaving and it will save in overall project costs. He noted that the total estimate for the replacement project is \$860,000 for sanitary sewer pipes, etc., noting that it will be a

reimbursement from the Authority to PennDOT. He noted that it is staff's recommendation that the Authority approve resolution 15-12 this evening authorizing our participation in this project.

Mr. Seeds noted that it is 100% so the Authority will not receive anything back on that. Mr. Wolfe answered that was correct. Mr. Crissman noted that this is a reimbursement to PennDOT, not from PennDOT.

Mr. Seeds questioned when the project will start. Mr. Wolfe answered that the tentative schedule is for next spring.

Ms. Lindsey questioned how much of Mountain Road will be paved. Mr. Wolfe answered that they will be replacing 1200 linear feet of 8 inch sanitary sewer... Ms. Lindsey questioned where does the project start and end on Mountain Road. Mr. Wolfe suggested that it starts outside of the Interstate right-of-way and proceeds north up to Linglestown, noting that the sanitary sewers have been replaced in the area of Linglestown. He suggested that it would be to Blue Ridge Avenue if not Linglestown Road.

Mr. Seeds suggested that the work would be from Route 22 to Blue Bird Avenue. Mr. Wolfe noted that he has a map. He explained that the memorandum provides station numbers but it does not list the cross streets.

Mr. Crissman questioned if the municipality can reimburse PennDOT in the same timely fashion as they have done for us in the past. He noted that was a tongue and cheek comment.

Mr. Wolfe noted that sanitary sewer will be replaced outside the interstate right-of-way on both sides of Mountain Road from the short stub in front of the car lot up to Ridgeview Road and it then skips over the Interstate where the next work is located at Lockwillow Avenue to about the Turkey Hill. He noted that he only has the sewer work map and not the map for the entire project.

Mr. Justin Eby made a motion to approve Resolution 15-12; authorizing the request to PennDOT for the reimbursement agreement for the North Mountain Road project. Mr. Crissman seconded the motion. Mr. Seeds called for a voice vote and a unanimous vote followed.

**Adjournment**

Mr. Crissman made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and the meeting adjourned at 7:46 p.m.
