

**LOWER PAXTON TOWNSHIP

Minutes of Township Authority Meeting held April 19, 2016

**Approval of Minutes**

Mr. Crissman made a motion to approve the March 15, 2016 business minutes of the Sewer Authority. Mr. Blain seconded the motion. Mr. Seeds call for a voice vote and a unanimous vote followed.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Resolutions 16-04, 16-05, and 16-06 authorizing  
relinquishing of sewer easements in the PC-4C/E projects

Mr. Stine noted that these resolutions are to relinquish previously condemned sewer easements that were required a couple of months ago. He noted in one case, the property owner subsequently signed a sewer easement agreement so it is no longer required, while others had a permanent easement that are no longer needed, although the temporary easements were needed but not the permanent ones. He noted that is what these resolutions are designed to do, to authorize the filing of a declaration of relinquishments so those properties are cleared for those particular reasons. He noted that they are ready for action this evening.

Mr. Seeds noted that all three are a little different as some are permanent and some are temporary. Mr. Stine noted that some are partials as well. Mr. Seeds questioned if we can approve them altogether. Mr. Stine answered yes.
